RULES OF THE

90 YEARS OF THE LVOV SHORTWAVE CLUB "THE CRADLE OF POLISH AMATEUR RADIO"

- 1. The diploma is issued by the Polish Amateur Radio Union and the Lvov Shortwave Club.
- 2. The goal of the diploma is to promote the Lvov city and commemorate the 90th anniversary of formation of the Lvov Shortwave Club "The cradle of Polish Amateur Radio".
- 3. For the diploma are valid all QSOs that will take place between January 1st and March 31st 2016 on all amateur bands, using all modes.
- 4. During the QSO standard RS(T) report is exchanged. Members as well as Honorary Members of the Lvov Shortwave Club are giving also their member ID card number.
- 5. QSOs taking place during ham radio contests, using repeaters as well as cross-band QSOs will not be accounted for the award.
- 6. In order to receive the award one has to collect at least 90 points.
- 7. Stations valid for the 90 years of the Lvov Shortwave Club "The cradle of Polish Amateur Radio" award and amount of points they'll give:
 - Stations with "90 LKK" suffix 15 pts.
 - Members of the Club from UR 10 pts.
 - Honorary members of the Club from SP 10 pts.

Special event stations: 3Z90LKK; HF90LKK; SN90LKK; SO90LKK; SP90LKK; SQ90LKK.

Honorary members of the Club from SP: SP2BMX; SP2JMR; SP2SGF; SP3IQ; SP5CCC; SP5HEN; SP5MDB; SP5QWJ; SP5VJO; SP5XVY; SP8AJC; SP8AQA; SP8AUP; SP8HAU; SP8HXU; SP8IQQ; SP8MI; SP8MRD; SP8NFE; SP8NFZ; SP8TK; SP9ATD; SP9EV; SP9IQO; SP9JPA; SP9LDB; SQ5ABG; SQ5HAU; SQ5MO; SQ7B; SQ8JLA; SQ9CWI.

- 8. Only one QSO with each station on each band and each mode will be accounted.
- 9. The Award Manager of the 90 years of the Lvov Shortwave Club "The cradle of Polish Amateur Radio" diploma is Vice-President of the Lvov Shortwave Club Zbigniew Guzowski SP8AUP.
- 10. Issuing fee: 15 zł, 5 euro or 5 \$. The fee has to be sent using bank transfer to the following account:
